

Read 2:2-13 How does the Holy Spirit animate the life of the Church? How does the hearing of the Gospel in many languages contrast to the tragedy of Babel? (Note 2:4)

Read 2:14-21 Peter quotes the prophet Joel 2:28-32 in his speech. What does this passage have to say about the messianic age and the Spirit, miracles, and wonders in the heavens? (Note 2:17-21)

Read 2:22-28 In Psalm 16:8-11, what is meant when the Psalmist says, "For you will not abandon my soul to Hades, nor let your Holy One see corruption."? (Note 2:25)

Read 2:29-36 Did God ensure that the Davidic dynastic line would continue forever? (Note 2:30)

What is the meaning of Psalm 110:1 "The Lord said to my Lord, sit at my right hand, till I make your enemies a stool for your feet."? (Note 2:34)

Topical Essay -- Peter, Prince of the Apostles

Was Peter lifted to an unrivaled position of honor and preeminence among the early Apostles? What are some examples of Peter's primacy in the Gospels and in the Book of Acts?

Read 2:37-42 What is the importance of baptism as it relates to salvation? Why did the apostles baptize entire households? (Note 2:38) (Note 2:39)

What is meant by the breaking of the bread? (Note 2:42)

Read 3:1-10 How do these two passages relate to the Messianic age?

"And leaping up he stood and walked and entered the temple with them, walking and leaping and praising God." (Acts 3:8)

"Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf unstopped; then the **lame shall leap** like a deer, and the tongue of the speechless sing for joy." (Isaiah 35:5-6)

Read 3:24-26 What is the covenant oath sworn by God to Abraham in Genesis 22:18? How is this promise fulfilled? (Note 3:25)
